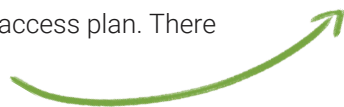

basics

all-access plans

Each all-access plan can be used for **unlimited** visits to our residential dining halls: Clohan Hall, McEwen Food Hall, and Lakeside Dining Hall. Swipe in as many times as you like for meals, snacks, or just to sit and chat between classes. All first year students are required to have an all-access plan. There are three different plans to choose from.

block plans

Block plans come with a set number of meals per semester and are only available to certain students depending on year and housing (not available to first year students).

Meal Dollars come with every meal plan, and can be spent at any EU Dining facility, much like a debit card. They are distributed twice per year and roll-over between semesters (must purchase same or higher priced meal plan in spring semester for meal dollars to transfer), but are dropped at the end of each year. If you run low on Meal Dollars, you can reload with Food Dollars

Food Dollars are a pre-paid declining balance account that can be spent exclusively in campus dining locations. They differ from Meal Dollars in that they are supplemental to your meal plan, and they stay on your account as long as you are enrolled at Elon University. You will also receive a 15% discount at retail locations anytime you pay with Food Dollars. Food Dollars may be added at any time through the Phoenix Card web portal, or just stop by the Phoenix Card office in McCoy Commons 201.

Phoenix Cash can be spent at any dining location just like a debit card, but also elsewhere around campus for a variety of services, including buying books or sending mail.

- are redeemable for a select combo meal; typically an entrée, side, and drink
- reload Wednesday of each week
- do not roll-over from week-to-week
